Dear Parents/Carers,

following regarding earrings in PE lessons:

The Association for Physical

Education (AfPE) advises that all jewellery, including earrings, should be removed before

participating in PE or swimming, as it presents an unnecessary risk of injury to the wearer and others.

Schools have a duty of care to

ensure safety and therefore cannot rely on taping or plastic retainers for safety during activity.

Therefore, we are asking for all

earrings to be removed before PE lessons start—older children can usually do this themselves. It might also be an idea to provide a box or bag for your child to keep them

secure in their bag. All children must take part in PE lessons unless there

is a medical reason for them not to.

Thank you for your co-operation on this.

1-3pm


