
Please can we remind parents that chocolate products are not allowed in home packed lunches.

Apps to support children's learning:

This year, we are launching Reading Eggs and Maths Seeds alongside TTRS (Times Table Rockstars) and Mathletics.







The target age for the apps are as follows:

Maths Seeds: 3-9 years Mathletics: 5-16 years

TTRS: 6+

Reading Eggs: 3 - 13

Your child will use these apps in school but will also have logins for use at home to support their learning. Mrs Barrow will start these in Acorn when the children are ready.
