

Uniform for all Pupils

The uniform, which is worn on any day that pupils do not have PE consists of:

Year 6 only:



Children in year 6 can wear a black jumper/sweatshirt with their polo shirt underneath. (Voted for by current year 5) These are available from many clothes outlets. The jumper must have a logo on. Two iron on logos will be given to each year 5 child, at the end of summer term. The rest of the uniform is the same as the other year groups.

All other year groups:



Iceni Academy white polo shirt** with academy logo on, available from Birds* **or** a plain white polo shirt.



Iceni Academy blue jumper or cardigan with a logo on, available from Birds*.

- Trousers or skirts can be purchased from anywhere and need to be black or grey. Skirts can be no higher than knee length.
- Pupils can also wear grey pinafore dresses.
- White, grey or black socks.
- Black suitable shoes with no bright colours. Either laced or Velcro fastening.

In the warmer months pupils can wear

- Blue and white gingham dresses.
- Black or grey shorts.

PE kit (Children come into school wearing their PE kit on the days that their class has PE):



Iceni Academy polo shirt with logo on from Birds*.



Navy blue or black shorts and socks



Navy blue or black tracksuit bottoms and navy-blue or black zippered PE jacket – optional but recommended in the colder months. These must be plain with no logos or brands on.



Dark coloured trainers with no bright colours on.



Blue bookbag for those **starting in Acorn class**. Given to the children by the school on their taster day.



Ruck sack if needed, preferably unbranded.

Please also note:

- Hair must be tied up for PE and any earrings removed.
- Students should not wear jewellery to school (apart from small stud earrings if ears are pierced).
- Students must not wear make-up or brightly coloured nail varnish.
- A wristwatch is allowed but no Smart watches.
- Wellington boots are optional for use outside in inclement weather. Please name them and keep in a carrier bag.
- Water bottles are given to pupils when they start school. Any brought from home should be no larger than 500 ml, to ensure there is enough space on the tables.

***Birds do provide badges that can be sewn onto any uniform that you buy.**
